ENTRY RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Date of Parade: Saturday, September 24, 2011 Step-off Promptly at 10am.
2. Registration shall only be accepted in writing. Entry forms are available on-Line www.duarteroute66parade.com or e-mail applications to valeriol@accessduarte.com
3. Parade line-up and staging will begin at 9am Saturday, September 18, 2010 in the following locations:
 - Bands: Big Lots Parking Lot @ Buena Vista and Huntington Drive
 - Walking Groups @ Bank of America Lot, Cotter Ave, south of Huntington Drive
 - Cars @ Cotter Ave, North of Huntington Drive
 - Equestrian Units @ LDS Church, Royal Oaks Drive and Cotter Avenue
4. ALL Units (Entries) MUST Check in with the Parade Marshal (Lisa Hernandez) at the "PARADE REGISTRATION BOOTH" on corner of Buena Vista and Huntington Drive.
5. Participants are asked to provide current information concerning their unit by September 11, 2010 for the parade announcer.
6. Under no circumstances shall any participant, unit or entry move to a different position within the parade line-up, before or during the parade, except under the direction of the Parade Marshal.
7. Participants riding in the parade will not be permitted to jump off and back onto units/entries while the parade is in progress. Such behavior will prevent participation in future parades for that participant.
8. Signs and Banners are encouraged for entrants to help spectators identify the entrant. We encourage entrants to participate with the theme of the 2010 parade:
"Get Your Groove On Route 66"
9. Units and Walkers/Marchers may not display signs or banners which promote a cause or could be considered by the average person to be a picket sign or banner.
10. Height Restriction: NO unit may be higher than twelve (12) feet from the pavement.
11. Width Restriction: ALL units must be able to fit inside one standard traffic lane.
12. Participants riding in vehicles or trailers must provide their own vehicles and drivers. Insurance and current registration MUST be provided with vehicle registration. Riders insurance and liability are the sole responsibility of the entrant.
13. All drivers must show a current, valid drivers license the day of the parade to the Parade Marshal and be at least 18 years old.
14. All motorized vehicles shall obey local laws regarding speed and hard helmets, when appropriate.
15. PARADE Participants are strictly prohibited from participating in any form of political campaigning, which includes but is not limited to the display of any political banners, campaign signs, buttons, t-shirts and literature. No participants will be permitted to display material advertising any candidacy for public office, nor shall there be any campaigning along the parade route. THIS IS A RULE THAT WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

16. Political Clubs or Organizations may NOT participate, since they are by definition, partisan. The Duarte Community Coordinating Council (DCCC), of which ROUTE 66 PARADE is a part, is a non-profit, tax-exempt IRS Section 501(c)(4) corporation, ID #95-4660816.
17. Elected officials serving Los Angeles County may participate with identifying car door signs with their name and current office. No political campaigning or advertising is allowed.
18. ABOLUTELY nothing may be thrown from a moving vehicle. Sponsors wishing to distribute gifts, coupons or merchandise, of any kind are permitted to "hand" such item to the spectators.
19. ALL animals shall be leashed, harnessed or other-wise restrained throughout the parade. You will be responsible for providing a clean-up crew for your animals.
20. **ALL Equestrian Units MUST** make prior arrangements in writing to have droppings "scooped" immediately. Please no autos, or motorized vehicles should be used for picking up the droppings. There will be an appropriately marked "DROPPING" bin at the disband area.
21. **The Parade Marshall will be on duty throughout the entire parade.** There will be appropriately noted assistants to the Parade Marshall at each Staging area as well as at various locations along the parade route to ensure the orderly progression of the parade itself. The Parade Marshall in conjunction with The Los Angeles County Sheriffs Department have the ultimate authority to remove any entry for any reason.
22. Participants on bicycles, scooters, skates, skateboards, etc must wear a helmet and proper safety equipment.
23. **No smoking is allowed by any participant in the staging area or in the Parade.**

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:

It is the responsibility of the entrants to obtain sufficient and appropriate insurance protection for their parade entry and those participating in the parade with the entrant.

The Route 66 Parade Committee reserves the right to refuse or remove or exclude any entry to this parade.

Parade Officials may deny participation to the parade on the day of the parade if, in the sole discretion of the Parade officials or Parade Marshal, the entrant has misrepresented any information on its PARADE ENTRY APPLICATION FORM, or if the entrant is deemed obscene, dangerous, provocative or in any way unsuitable for the parade.
